AGE GROUPS Age Groups are determined by year of birth. (A wrestlers birthday as of December 31, 2010)

Proof of age will be required if wrestler is challenged within the first two rounds of competition. A birth certificate is the only form of validation that will be accepted.

## **RULES** Modified High School Rules

- Must be in grade 8<sup>th</sup> or under. Anyone born in 94 must send proof they're in 8<sup>th</sup> when registering for MYWA.
- All Michigan residents 8<sup>th</sup> grade and under <u>MUST</u> be a MYWA member to compete in post season events.
- Age Groups 06-04, 03-02: three, 1 minute periods
- Age Groups 01-00, 99-98, 97-96 (95 8<sup>th</sup> grade only): three, 1 1/2 minute periods
- Singlets or t-shirt and shorts are required.
- One step on scale at weigh-ins
- Mouth guards **Mandatory** for wrestlers with braces
- Hair caps attached to headgear **Mandatory** for wrestlers not groomed to HS standards. (Hair length must be above eyebrow, earlobes, and collar.)
- If less than three wrestlers are in a weight class, the tournament has the right to move them up one weight class (in the same age group) except for heavyweight.
